We hope to have further information once the Elections are over and can get everyone together.

### **STREETLIGHTS**

The Parish Council have agreed to a new solar panel streetlight to be placed on the corner of the Memorial hall bank next to the junction of Church Lane and Lowes Lane.

Timers have also been agreed to be placed in the other 7 streetlights to come when dusk but turned completely off at 10 pm until 5.30am. The lights will then come on from 5.30 am until daylight. This will be completed in the next few months.
