### Update from Previous Minutes

- Public Right of Way on Creake Road. This was reported and the Norfolk County Council have replied: This problem did not meet our criteria for repair. We will monitor it as part of routine inspections. **Additional officer notes:**  
This route has been inspected. At the time of inspection it was found to be passable on foot, however it is becoming overgrown and will be cleared on the next round of cutting.
- Public Right of Way opposite Church: This was report and Norfolk County Council have responded: We were unable to find this problem. It may have already been repaired. If not, please report it again providing as much information as possible to help us locate it. **Additional officer notes:** There is no stile at this location; there is an old kissing gate with a gap next to it accessible for users of the footpath. There is a stile approximately 190m north which is in poor condition. This is not used as there is a large gap next to it. Defect not found by inspector
- Appraisal – To be arranged.
- Old Railway Line – Still ongoing with Legal Services at Norfolk County Council.
- Dog Bin opposite Dog Area – Waiting on a response.
