## NEWSLETTER JUNE 2021

### THE LORD NELSON PUBLIC HOUSE

Holkham gave a presentation at the Annual Parish Meeting on 5<sup>th</sup> May, showing the pub's new layout and introducing Woodforde's Brewery as the new tenants. An open event will be held, with more details on this when received, and the pub now plans to re-open on 21st June. Working with the National Museum for the Royal Navy, Holkham Estates plan to establish a Lord Nelson museum in the small building by the pub. There was also a presentation of plans for 12-15 rooms for overnight stays. These plans will be discussed at an extra meeting for the Parish Council. Dates to be arranged.

### FUTURE BIOGAS, EGMERE

Meetings have taken place with Egmore Energy. Egmore Energy will liaise with parish councils directly affected by feedstock delivery, providing details of when the harvest is likely to take place and routes. Egmore Energy will be placing signs on all their trailers so they can be recognised and there will be a helpline for the public to report any problems.

### FLOODING AND SEWAGE

All parishes affected by the flooding should have received a letter from the Norfolk Resilience Forum. This should include all key contacts in case of flooding.

### WIFI IN THE VILLAGE HALL

As the Government has not renewed legislation allowing virtual meetings this has been placed on hold.

### CHERRY TREES AT THE GOODRICKS

The Parish Council has agreed to send a letter to the Borough Council asking if a tree preservation order can be placed on cherry trees at The Goodricks.

### SURVEY FOR LOWERING SPEED LIMITS

Following a low response, the Parish Council decided to hold another survey after lockdown.

### COMMON LAND

The horses on the common have been removed, following a notice on the common to do so.

### SPEED AWARENESS MESSAGE (SAM2) RESULTS

The data was analysed and revealed that on Walsingham Road, near Whitehall Farm there is significant speeding well in excess of 30mph into the village. This will be reported to the Police.

### ELECTION AT THE PARISH COUNCIL

Mima Garland and Valerie Southerland were re-elected as Chair and Vice-Chair for another year.
